APERITIF AND VERMOUTH

An aperitif is an alcoholic beverage served before a meal to stimulate the appetite. (30ML)

Vermouth is a fortified and aromatized wine. Basically, a wine spiked with brandy, infused with roots, barks, herbs, spices and sweetened. There are two main varieties: red (sweet) vermouth and white (dry) vermouth. Fresh vermouth is the key ingredient to any classic cocktail and just like aperitif's, it is a great way to begin your meal. (30ML)

GIN

Gin's roots date back to 16th century Holland, and the different types that have emerged are as different as the eras they were produced in. (30ML)

There are 5 different styles of Gin: London Dry, Plymouth, Genever, Old Tom and International style.

- London Dry are typically dry, heavily juniper flavored, light in body, and aromatic.
- Plymouth is less dry and can only be made in Plymouth, England. This style of Gin has an earthier flavor with softer juniper notes.
- Genever is very different in colour and taste from other gins. They are made from malt grains, which gives it its darker colour and flavour that is more similar to a light bodied whiskey.
- Old Tom is a sweeter style of Gin. It is the preferred gin used in the classic cocktail Tom Collins.
- International Style Gin: is an umbrella term used to refer to all new styles of gin using the same base distilling process but are predominately infused with flavours other than juniper berries.

PISCO

Pisco is a white spirit that has been distilled only once and has been produced entirely in the country of Peru or Chile. The way the grapes are used defines the type of pisco. (30ML)

The three types of pisco are:

- Puro (pure)
Pisco made using only one grape varietal
- Acholado (multivarietal)
Pisco made using 2 or more grape varietals
- Mosto Verde (green must)
Distilled from partially fermented must

SCOTCH WHISKY

In order to be considered a single malt scotch, the whisky must come from a single distillery and be made from malted barley. From here the liquid must be aged for a minimum of three years in oak casks before being bottled. (30ML)

HIGHLANDS

Whiskies from this region are very difficult to generalise in flavour as the region is large and there are four distinct sub-regions; North, West, East and South. Each displaying a different style and flavour profile, which can range from sweet to dry.

The Island of Islay (pronounced 'Eye-La') produce whiskies that are renowned for their dryness and strong peaty smokiness. Examples of distilleries include Lagavulin and Laphroaig.

ISLANDS

Each island carries its own characters, although usually a slight salinity can be found, thanks to the sea vicinity. Some islands will often have a more volcanic character (Talisker), others will have more of a honey and smoky malt (Highland Park) or a malty and rich character (Arran). (30ML)

BLENDDED SCOTCH

Blended scotch whisky is the combination of malt and grain whiskies, matured for at least 3 years in oak. Roughly 90% of all scotch produced today goes into making blends. Flavor profile can vary as House's have their own unique style; Johnnie Walker produce rich and complex scotch while Dewar's produce a more sweeter and honeyed scotch. (30ML)

IRISH WHISKEY

The Irish are credited with being the first to distill whiskey, although this may become a heated debate with the Scots. Whiskey coming from Ireland may be single malt, grain, blended or pure pot still. Peat is rarely used in the malting process, so that the whiskey has a smoother finish as opposed to the smoky and earthy flavors common to some Scotch whisky. (30ML)

JAPANESE WHISKY

Whisky has been a very important part of Japanese culture and it's largely attributed to its two founding fathers: Shinjiro Torii and Masataka Taketsuru. When tasting some of these spirits, they can tend to lie between Lowland and Speyside in style. Delicate and perfumed with honeyed sweetness but some display a little peat like in the hakushu peated expression. (30ML)

By law, bourbon whiskey must contain a mash bill of no less than 51% corn, distilled to no more than 160 proof and aged in new charred oak barrels. (30ML)

WORLD WHISKEY/WHISKY/POITIN

This is a category that cannot be defined. Unlike Scotland, Ireland or America, these come from countries without a strong history of whisky production, therefore the laws regarding their production vary. These whiskies are unpredictable, which is what make them so interesting.

Poitin (potcheen) is a traditional Irish distilled beverage. It can be described as Irish moonshine. It is made from either cereals, grain, whey, sugar beet, molasses or potatoes. (30ML)

TEQUILA

Tequila is produced from the blue agave plant. It can only be made in Mexico and only in one of five states. Tequila will either come from the Highlands or Lowlands of Mexico and both give a distinct flavor profile.

Highland agave plants are bigger and richer with a longer growing cycle. This region produces a more sweeter and fruitier style with floral hints.

Agave plants from the Lowlands have a shorter growing cycle and give tequila a more earthy and herbaceous flavor and are sometimes spicier. (30ML)

MEZCAL & SOTOL

Mezcal is one of Mexico's native spirits still made in a traditional manner. It mainly comes from the state of Oaxaca, but can also be produced in eight other regions. Several types of agave are used in the production and distillation of Mezcal. The smokey and earthy flavours of Mezcal come from the harvested pina's being cooked underground for 2-3 days.

Sotol is a spirit in Mexico made from the native plant called the Desert Spoon. It specifically comes from the rocky desert soils of Chihuahua, Durango and Coahuila. Flavor wise, Sotol tends to sometimes exhibit a grassier flavor with gentle floral notes. (30ML)

RUM & CACHACA

Are spirits made from sugarcane byproducts, such as molasses, or directly from sugar cane juice. Rum is not limited to only being made in the tropics, they can be distilled anywhere in the world. However, there are some exceptions, such as rum agricole from Martinique and cachaça from Brazil. (30ML)
